III. Expressions of Worship

#### 1. Speaking

**Psalm 34:1**. I will bless the Lord at all times; His praise shall continually be in my mouth.

#### 2. Shouting

a. **Psalm 27:6**. Then my head will be exalted above the enemies who surround me; at his tabernacle will I sacrifice with shouts of joy; I will sing and make music to the Lord.

#### 3. Singing

- a. **Psalms 66:4**. All the earth will [bow down to] worship You [in submissive wonder], And will sing praises to You; They will praise Your name in song.
- b. **Psalm 47:6**. Sing praises to God, sing praises to our King, sing praises.

#### 4. Dancing

**Psalm 149:3**. Let them praise his name with dancing and make music to him with tambourine and harp.

# 5. Giving

#### 2 Corinthians 8-9

- a. Those who follow Jesus should excel in the grace of giving.
- b. Giving is an expression of the love one has for Jesus.
- c. God loves willing and cheerful givers.
- d. A willingness to be generous in giving is more important than the amount given.
- e. Our giving will result in praise and thanksgiving to God.
- f. Our giving should be a natural response to God's gracious gift to mankind.

## IV. Postures of Worship

#### 1. Bowing
