Getting baptized and joining a local church are crucial first steps in the Christian journey, but what truly matters the most is developing a personal connection or relationship with God, with Jesus our beloved savior.

Getting to know and understand the person you're entering a relationship with is crucial, and this applies to your relationship with God as well.

It's important to grasp the fundamental nature and character of God in order to

cultivate a healthy connection with Him. Misinterpreting His character and nature often leads to distance from Him, which is why it's essential to know Him.

communication throughout the day.
For exampleWhen you feel discouraged, you remind yourself of His promise in
Isaiah 41:10, "Don't be discouraged, don't be dismayed, Fear not, I'll be with
you wherever you go." You hold onto those words and express gratitude to the
Lord, committing to take the next step of obedience. In that moment, you
experience a deep connection and communion with God. This is how you walk
with Him moment by moment in your life.
II. Communing With God
God, the King of all kings is an unimaginably great friend who cares for us. He is
not flesh, He is a spirit. We cannot touch Him, but we can feel Him. We cannot
see Him, but we can experience Him. He is not an abstract, He is real.
We can with God, and we can be with
God. To commune means to focus on, converse with, talk to, often with
profound intensity, transparency, and honesty.
To develop a relationship with God, we must
